Towards equality, dignity and justice for Israeli women living under Jewish laws

to compel civil courts to intervene when religious courts violate the rights of women denied a get (writ of divorce)

to recast public perception of get refusers as committing civil wrongs rather than possessing halachic rights

to secure individual damage awards of up to \$200,000 for female victims of get refusal, setting 50 precedents across Israel

to force the Rabbinate to permit all Jewish women, regardless of relationship status or religiosity, to use publicly-funded ritual baths

to demand and secure the same number of slots on the Committee for Appointment of Rabbinic Judges for women as for men

to expose and challenge Rabbinate's right to revoke conversions and maintain a blacklist of children and suspected adulteresses

to demand gender equality for public-sphere privileges

to force Rabbinate to change unjust policies, such as discriminatory job offers and taxpayer-funded bribes to recalcitrant husbands
